- Andy Bahr reminded everyone about going to Escape to Margaritaville at Bass Hall. A group of 15 needed to get discount but seating does not have to be together.

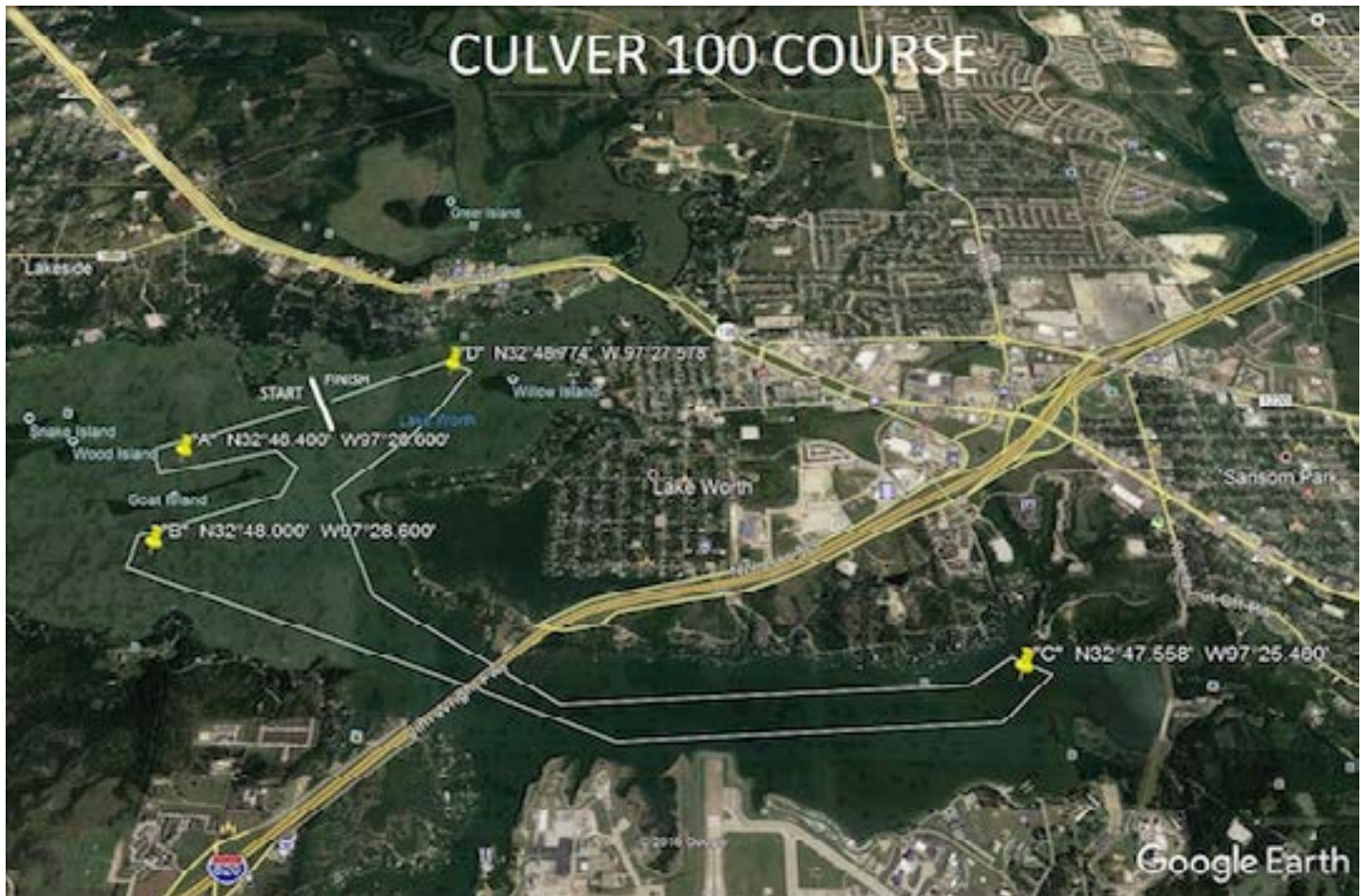
Meeting adjourned at 1345hrs.
