### Secretary's Report ~ Andy Katz

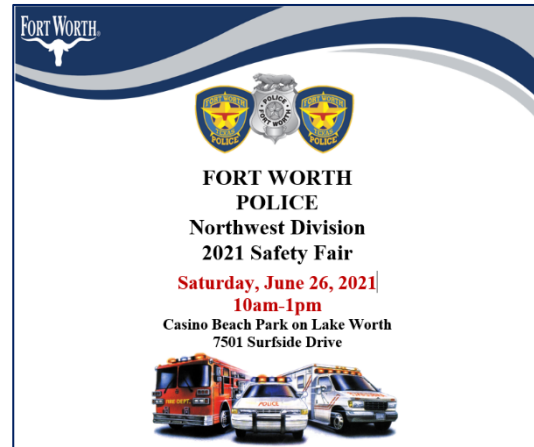
